Companies can publish the traineeship offers on one of two platforms – **Drop'pin@EURES** or **ErasmusIntern** – or they can advertise through direct contacts with university careers offices or international relations offices. The universities select candidates for traineeships based on specific criteria, and the company will choose the trainee from a pre-selected pool of candidates.

The EU-funded Digital Opportunity Traineeships initiative will offer up to 6000 students and recent graduates the chance to improve their digital skills on the job in a company in a participating country. Traineeships will take place from spring 2018 to the end of 2020. Traineeships can last between 2 and 12 months. Each trainee will receive an allowance of around  $\in$ 500 a month through the initiative. Companies are encouraged to top up this allowance.
